Beds that are infested with moths, are cleansed and preserved from further depredation, without any waste of feathers—nothing being removed but dampness, dirt, &c. Those who wish it, can have their beds dressed the same day, and sent home high, light and elastic, as when they were new, although they may have been in use a great number of years. Beds that are diseased from any sickness, such as cholera, &c. cured complete, and rendered more pleasant than new.
